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Kim Jones got all of the fashion world buzzing about his latest Menswear Collection for Fall 2022 in London, England December 9, 2021. The show's production paid tribute to <u>On the Road</u> author Jack Kerouac. <u>On the Road</u> was a cultural shift for the post World War II era. 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The show however, did not feature K-pop sensation Sehun. Sehun has been a huge draw for the Dior brand as a whole. With expectations of his presence, tons of viewers tuned into the virtual live stream of the show. Fans were expecting to see him walk and were disappointed when he wasn't featured. The livestream feed comments were flooded with comments about this K-pop star. Although he was not in the show, having Sheun as a Dior Menswear Ambassador has proved to be a keen decision by Dior. Sehun has introduced many new Dior fans to the brand. Jones perfectly chose the pop star specifically to create buzz, which paid off and drew lots of positive publicity.

Despite the show's absence of Sehun, it was a hit! The collection, the music, and the overall production drew accolades from fashion insiders and notables.
